1. When there comes the Help of Allâh (to you, O Muhammad [sal-Allâhu 'alayhi wa sallam]) and the Conquest (of Makkah). 2. And you see that the people enter Allâh's religion (Islâm) in crowds. 3. So, glorify the Praises of your Lord, and ask His forgiveness. Verily, He is the One Who Ever accepts the repentance and Who forgives.



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1. Say (O Muhammad [sal-Allâhu 'alayhi wa sallam] to these Mushrikûn and Kâfirûn): "O Al-Kâfirûn (disbelievers in Allâh, in His Oneness, in His Angels, in His Books, in His Messengers, in the Day of Resurrection, and in Al-Qadar)! 2. I worship not that which you worship, 3. Nor will you worship that which I worship. 4. And I shall not worship that which you are worshipping. 5. Nor will you worship that which I worship. 6. To you be your religion, and to me my religion (Islâmic Monotheism).

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Verily, We have granted you (O Muhammad [sal-Allâhu 'alayhi wa sallam]) Al-Kauthar (a river in Paradise). 2] Therefore turn in prayer to your Lord and sacrifice (to Him only). 3] For he who hates you (O Muhammad [sal-Allâhu 'alayhi wa sallam]), he will be cut off (from posterity and every good thing in this world and in the Hereafter).

What is Kauthar ?

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Perish the two hands of Abû Lahab (an uncle of the Prophet [sal-Allâhu 'alayhi wa sallam]) and perish he! His wealth and his children will not benefit him! He will be burnt in a Fire of blazing flames! And his wife too, who carries wood (thorns of Sa'dân which she used to put on the way of the Prophet [sal-Allâhu 'alayhi wa sallam], or used to slander him). In her neck is a twisted rope of Masad (palm fiber).
